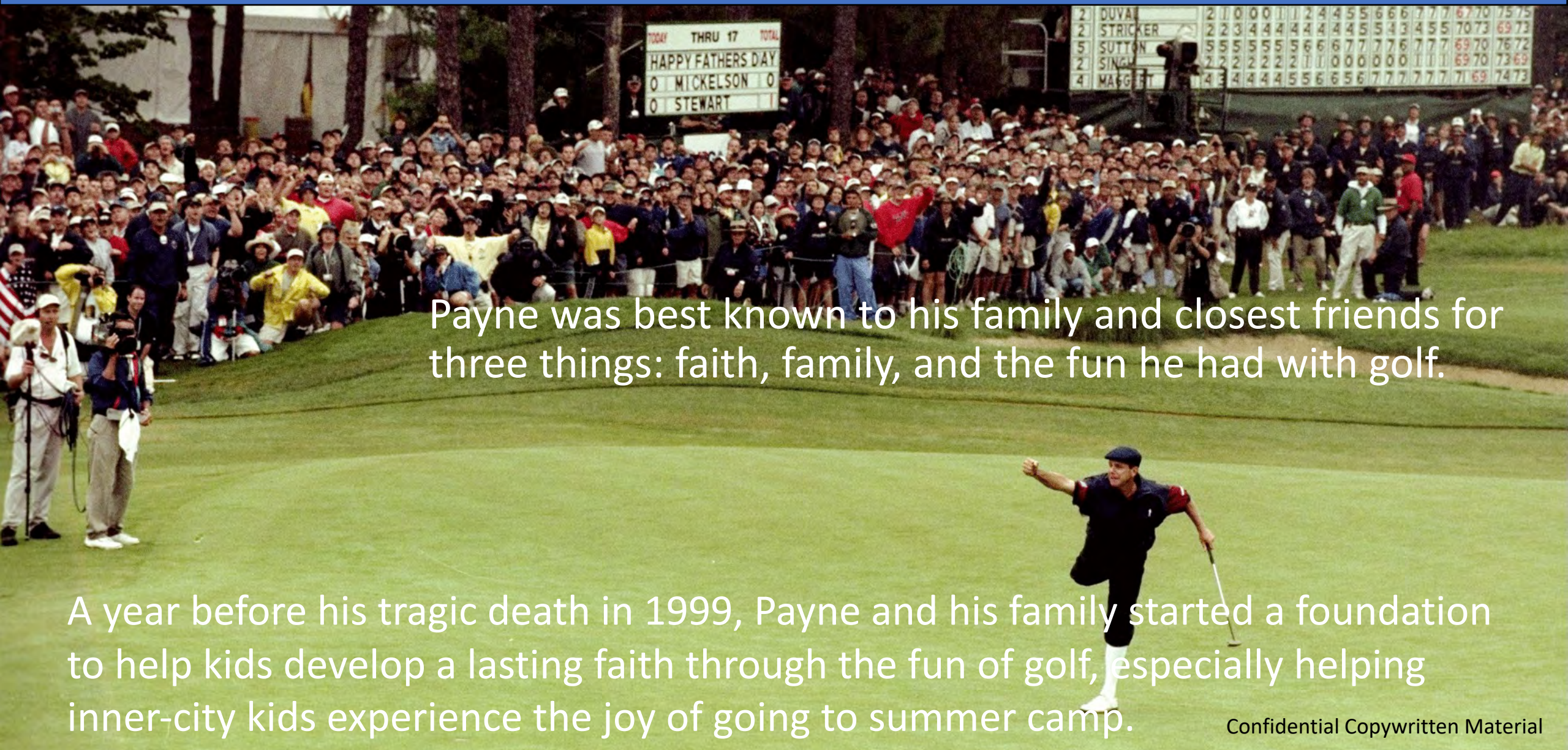




Standing On the Iconic Legacy of Payne Stewart

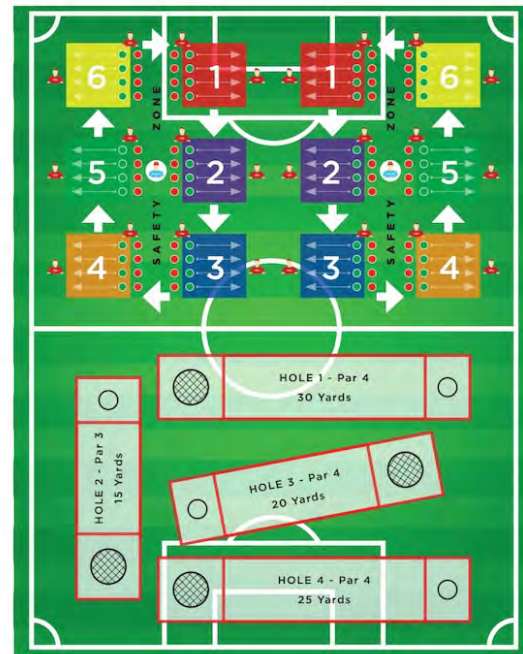
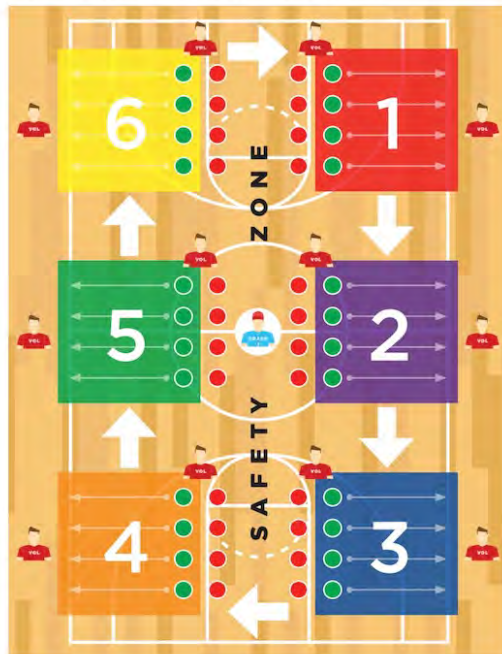
Complete golf camp/ clinic learning station programming/layout and daily agenda.

GROUPING & STATIONS

Payne Stewart Golf Camps are designed to be run at indoor or outdoor facilities. The difference between the two different facilities or spaces are the number of participants that the camp can accommodate. An indoor camp can accommodate 40-60 kids in a full court gymnasium. In contrast a soccer field or green grass space could accommodate double or triple the number of participants that a gymnasium could hold.

As leaders you will be equipped to organize the space as recommended in order to best instruct the participants. The most important thing to remember is the spacing of children in order to run a safe and organized camp. Refer to the diagram that best represents the type of facility that your camp is being run in/on.

*At each station children should be placed approximately 3 ft. apart.
