


Standing On the Iconic Legacy of Payne Stewart

PHASE I – Off-Course Learning & Play

Phase I – In local neighborhoods

- > Training in any gym or outdoor green grass space
- > Focusing on kids 4-7 (and 8+ if never played before)
- > Using Phase I Payne Stewart Learning Equipment
- > Introduction to all four golf skills Game-based play

PHASE II – Close-Course Training

Phase II - Driving Ranges and Few Schools


- > Training typically at a golf course driving range
- > Focusing on kids 8 and older
- > Jr Golf Clubs Cut down adult club versions same ball
- > Instruction-based teaching

PHASE III – On-Course Play

Phase III - Junior Training Programs


- > Training and skill development on mostly on-course
- > Kids 8+ who have demonstrated playing ability
- > Advanced Junior Golf Clubs
- > Competitive play options




